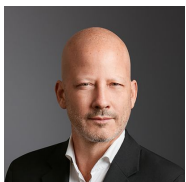

On May 11, 2009, Christine Varney, head of the antitrust division at the Department of Justice announced The White House will be repudiating the Bush Administration's approach toward antitrust guidelines on illegal monopolies.
